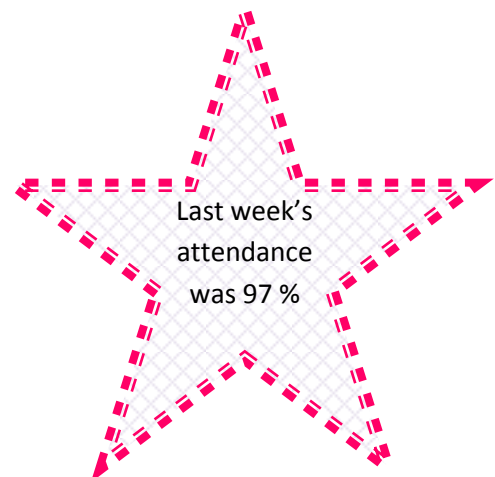
The Finance committee will meet on Tues 29<sup>th</sup> Sept at 5pm.
