Thank you all again for your continued support of our school fundraising ventures.



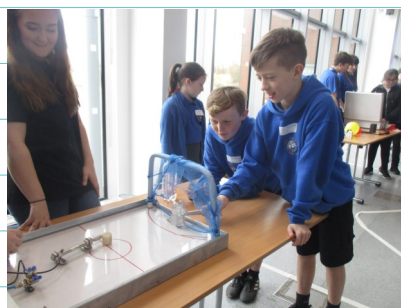
MORE ATHLETICS SUCCESS
